The Enid Kiwanis Club has set forth the following expectations for the all committee chairs with respect to their individual committees.

- **Rides Committee** - be the liaison between the club regarding park operations. Oversee the general workings of the park rides, be the contact for the employee's (if any), coordinate private parties and schedule work days for routine maintenance of the rides throughout the year.
- **Special Project Fundraising** - oversee fundraising; coordinate with the rides committee what maintenance is needed when money is available.
- **Special Events** – coordinate banquets, picnics and any other special events throughout the year. This includes but does not limit to: Installation banquet, Christmas Party, Valentine's Party and Hamburger Picnic.
- **Community Service** – be the public liaison for community service requests; organize community service projects if applicable. Examples: Salvation Army Bell Ringing, Little Olympics and Kiwanis One Day. Ideas from KI are provided at the following website for Kiwanis One Day projects.

- **Young Children/Priority One** – an ongoing service program of Kiwanis International, addressing the needs of young children. Kiwanis clubs are encouraged to carry out at least two YCPO projects per calendar year, though many clubs are able to do more— helping children, families, and communities with critical issues affecting youth. YCPO projects are divided into four categories. 1) Maternal and Infant Health, 2) Child Care & Development, 3) Parent Education & Support, 4) Safety & Pediatric Trauma.
