Due to moving and work commitments, member **Lorenzo Dunford** has resigned from our club. We wish him and his family the best!

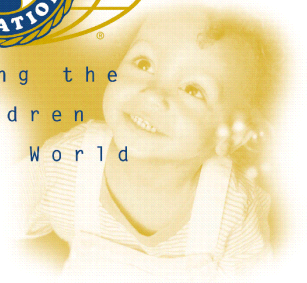
